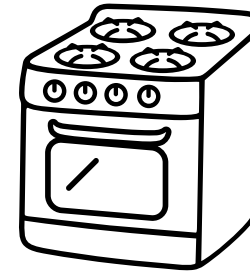

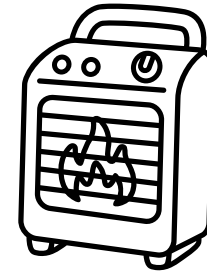
Patio Heater



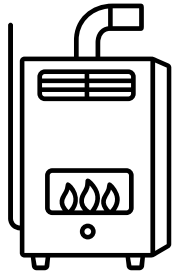

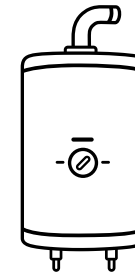

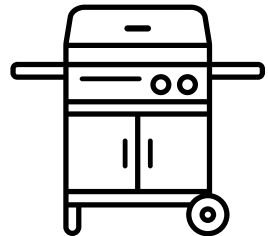
